## General Conditions:

The competitions will be run according to VÖS regulations and are open to all FINA clubs.
We start this year according to the one-start-rule (only one start-attempt per heat).
Lanes will be given out regardless of age according to the best times on the entry lists.
Class divisions and Scoring for all 100 m events:
Female by year of birth for years 1992-1995, grouped for the years 1996 and younger / 1991 and older
Male by year of birth for years 1991-1995, grouped for the years 1996 and younger / 1990 and older

Multi-Stroke Scoring: Those swimmers starting in all 4 strokes will receive a total score, divided by year of birth. These points will be added together according to the FINA Short Course 1000-point table.
The 5 best-placed male and female participants in each age-group qualify for the McDonald's Finals (events 25-37).
These finals cover 100 m Individual Medley.
Credit-Rule: If a swimmer is disqualified in a 100m-event (and only then), he/she gets only once in the whole competition the possibility, to swim again this distance before the end of the competition section. The time swum and FINA-points of this credit-100m will count only for the multi-stroke and for reaching the finals. Lanes will be given by the organization committee. One official of the team has to claim for the credit-100m immediately after publication of the single results at the speaker's desk. Improvement of the multi-stroke cup record is not possible after taking advantage of the credit-rule

Relays: The Freestyle relays are open, the Ind. Medley relays are swum as Junior Relays (female: 93 and younger, male: 91 and younger)

## 200 m Freestyle:

Female grouped for the years 91 and 92 as for 93 and younger and 90 and older Male grouped for the years 89 and 90 as for 91 and younger and 88 and older The middle age-groups are according to the European Junior Championship age-classes.

Team Scoring: The top 5 in the single 100 m events receive between for $\mathbf{5 - 1}$ points for their team qcore - but only the best participant of each club can get points! So the 15 points are divided to 5 different teams. Double points are given for the Relays: between 2 and 10. Double points are given for the Freestyle-Relays (events 11, 12): between 2 and 10.

Entries should be sent preferable in an electronic form according to Lenex, DSV, CIS_Online or the available Excel-file (download). For electronic entries will be a discount of 50 cent per race to the starting money. Every Information or file you will find at: http://www.msecm.at/17mlc/17mlc.htm

Swimmers entered in all 4 strokes automatically take part in the Multi-Stroke Scoring (and can only qualify for the finals in this way).

Due to the number of entries in last years, clubs are asked to enter only those swimmers who have achieved the guidline times in at least 2 of the 4 disciplines
