### General Terms:

#### 1. Eligible:

For the Masters Competition for the **Heindl-Bandagist Trophy** all swimmers, who have the right to compete for an association duly registered at FINA.

2. The FINA competition rules will be applied.

3. The number of starts per swimmer for the **Masters-Competition for the Heindl-Bandagist Trophy** is limited to 6. The competitions 39, 40, 65, 66 were added to the program to enable swimmers, to reach the limit for the Masters EM in London. Registries with times above this limit will not be accepted. In the case that there are too many registries, the starts will be fixed by draw and/or 2 swimmers will be started using the same lane. The definite readiness to start at these competitions has to be signed-up at the beginning of the first day of the competition.

4. The competition will be organized in heats. The heats will be put together according to the times indicated in the registry.

5. Heats of female and male Masters of the same competition can be put together according to FINA-Masters rule MSW 3.1 to fill up heats.

#### 6. Ranking and Age Classes:

The age classes are corresponding to the FINA rules.

### Masters-Competition for the Heindl-Bandagist Trophy and Upper Austrian Masters Championship:

Age class (AK), individual ranking:

<b>AK25</b>	<b>AK30</b>	<b>AK35</b>	
87-91	82-86	77-81	etc. in 5 years steps as required

Age class (AK), relay ranking (age of 4 swimmers added up, whereby no swimmer may be younger than 25 years):

<b>AK 100</b>	<b>AK 120</b>	<b>AK 160</b>	
100 – 119	120 – 159	160 – 199	etc. in 40 years steps as required.

7. Registration to be made in electronic form in the format Lenex or online under [www.msecm.at](http://www.msecm.at) until closing of registration. Registration arriving too late will not be considered.

The registration has to be also sent as an electronic paper copy to the registration address. Another copy has to be sent via email to [office@1lsk.com](mailto:office@1lsk.com) until closing of the registration. In this email the representative of the participating swimming association has to be named, who will represent the association during the competition. To this person starting fees paid too much will be reimbursed.

Starting fee:

€ 4.50-- for each individual start

€ 7.50—for each relay start

The starting fee has to be paid to the account of 1.LSK Heindl (**IBAN: AT52 1500 0007 2101 2979 BIC OBKLAT2L**) until closing of the registration!

An case of late payment the registration will be rejected.

9. Rewards:

The first 3 of each competition and age class will receive medals.

10. Not relevant.

11. Winner of the **Masters-Competition for the Heindl-Bandagist Trophy** is the Masters Swimmer, achieving the highest total of points according to the DSV-Masters-Table.

12. Miscellaneous

With the written registration each participant confirms his fitness for the swimming sport, which could be checked by analysing the swimmers pass.

Non Austrian associations declare by their recording of the registration that their national swimming association is member of FINA and that all registered swimmers have the title to start according to their national swimming association rules. If the national swimming association requires a permit for the start outside of the country, this permit has to be provided upon request.
