Minis:

MINIS can start over 25m in all 4 swim strokes. (2010 and younger female, 2010 and younger male)

Masters:

MASTERS can swim 100m medley, 50m in all 4 swim strokes, 200m medley and 4x50m Freestyle Mixed Relay.

Age groups and Youths:

Age group and youths can start over 200m medley and 50m in all 4 swim strokes.

Juniors and Open:

Juniors and Open class swimmers can start over 200m medley and 50m in all 4 swim strokes.

Awards:

Minis will be awarded for every individual competition.

For **MASTERS**, **age groups**, **youths**, **juniors and open** class swimmers the best three results (performance points, for **MASTERS** assessed by the DSV Masterstable) will be added to determine the overall winner.

Prize money for Open- and Junior class swimmers!

Open: 1st. 150 € / 2nd. 100 € / 3rd. 70 €

Juniors: 1st. 150 € / 2nd. 100 € / 3rd. 70 €

AUSTRALIAN FINAL:

The 10 fastest swimmers over 200m Medley of age groups 2003 – 2009 (female) and 2002 – 2009 (male) swim the Australian Final (female and male separate).

In four consecutive heats (100m Medley, start every 5 minutes) the two slowest swimmers drop out.

This will be repeated until the winner of the two fastest swimmers is found. (last heat 100m medley with 2 starters)

After that the Australian Final of age groups 2002 and older (female), and 2001 and older (male) takes place. The winners of age groups 2002 and older (female) and 2001 and older (male) are awarded **prize money of 70 €**.

Winners of age groups 2003 – 2009 (female) and 2002 – 2009 (male) receive material prizes.

At the end of the ATUS Graz SPRINT CHALLENGE an Australian Final 4x50m Freestyle MIXED RELAY will be held.

10 Mixed relays start over 4x50m Freestyle. The two slowest relays drop out after every heat (start every 6 minutes). It is not allowed to switch the order of the starters.

Should there be more than 10 relays, two or more preliminary heats will be held to determine the 10 fastest relays.

After competition no. 22 there will be a ONE HOUR break. This time can be used for warm-up. Competition no. 23 will start 60 minutes after the end of competition no. 22.



General Regulations:

Competition rules of the Austrian Swimming Association apply. Events will be held in timed heats.

Masters:

According to Masters rules Masters swimmers of all age groups are swimming together in one event but will be counted according to their age group.

Registration, Participation and Starting Allowence:

According to §7 and §10 of the general competitions rules of the Austrian Swimming Federation. Non-Austrian clubs declare with the registration that they belong to a national federation of the FINA and that all registered athletes possess the right to start for the club. A permission of the national federation to start abroad has to be presented. With the handed in registrations the clubs reassure that the registered swimmers can prove their health and that the health testing is not older than 12 months from the registration deadline.

Registrations:

Have to be conducted via LENEX File or online under <http://www-cis-online.net>. The registration times will be taken automatically from the Online-System of the Austrian Swimming Federation. Only times that have been swum in a 25m or 50m pool from the 1st of April 2017 are going to be considered. The LENEX file can be downloaded under the following link: <http://www.msecm.at>
