**Eligibility to register, participate and start:** According to WKBSW swimmers from age group 13 are allowed to participate in the Austrian National Championships. Active swimmers in age groups 13-16 may participate in a maximum of 6 individual events, younger athletes are not allowed to participate. All participants registered for a member club of the OSV must be duly registered according to WKBSW. This also means that all documents of the athletes must be uploaded in the online system of the OSV at the time of the entry deadline.

Non-Austrian clubs declare with the submission of the entry that they belong to a national member federation of FINA and that all registered athletes have the right to start for the club. A foreign start permit according to the requirements of their national federation must be presented upon request.

**General class:age group** 2010 and older

**Junior class:** Age group 2005 and 2006 (AK 18/ 17)

With the submission of the entry the registering clubs assure that the swimmers registered by them can prove their sport health and the examination at the time of the entry deadline is not longer than 12 months ago.

**General regulations:** The competitions will be held according to the FINA and OSV competition regulations.

The starting places of the swimmers in the preliminary heats and time heats will be set according to the best times according to the WKBSW of the OSV. In the final heats the 10 fastest swimmers of the preliminary heats of each competition are eligible to participate. The starting places will be set according to the WKBSW of the OSV.

In competitions in which preliminary heats are held, in addition to the final heats with the 10 fastest of the preliminary heats, B-finals will be held. The B-finals will be held before the A-finals. A maximum of 3 non-Austrian participants can take part in each final run. The three fastest of the A-final run will receive medals if the compulsory times are reached.

One relay team per club is allowed to start in each event.

The three fastest Austrian participants of the A final run will receive medals if the compulsory times are reached. The winner of the international classification will receive an award.

The Austrian junior champions (w/m) will be determined in the preliminary heats and will receive medals if the compulsory times are reached. The juniors will not be seeded separately.

Failure to meet mandatory times within the 18 months prior to the entry deadline or during the competition, failure to meet entries, or failure to announce a final forfeit within the drop deadline will result in a penalty fee in accordance with the WKBSW.

**With the submission of the entry each participating club has to nominate judges according to the number of entered athletes per competition section!**

0-2 athletes = no referee; 3-7 athletes = 1 referee; 8 athletes or more = 2 referees.

For each judge not provided a penalty fee according to the scale of fees has to be paid.

**Messages:**

Must be submitted according to the WKBSW of the OSV (reference is made to the AWKB of the OSV). The entry times are automatically determined from the online best list system of the OSV. For this purpose only times will be taken into account, which have been determined within the last 18 months before the entry deadline at a competition on a 25m- or 50m-lane. Austrian citizens who are members of a foreign FINA club have to declare their times according to the above mentioned period. If this is not done or if incorrect entry times are given, these entries will be rejected.

**Deadline:** Wednesday, 06 December 2023, 20:00 received

**Any reports received after this date will not be accepted without exception!**

After the registration deadline, a confirmation of registration will be sent, this must be checked immediately and errors must be reported to the registration address by Thursday, 07 December, 20:00. Corrections received later will not be considered without exception.

The entry fee is to be paid immediately after receipt of the invoice after the competition.

**Penalty:** According to the WKBSW of the OSV, in particular, if a swimmer misses the compulsory time specified for the meet and he/she cannot show proof of compulsory time on a 25m or 50m lane during the specified qualification period, a repentance fee of five times the entry fee will be collected. The compulsory time proof is determined from the OSV best list system.



**Notification of the club representative:** With the submission of the entry, each club has to announce its official club representative at these championships by name.

**Doping control:** We would like to point out that doping controls may be carried out during the event. The corresponding regulations of the NADA (National Anti Doping Agency) are to be observed.

**Photo/Filming:** It is expressly pointed out that during the event photo and film recordings will be made by persons accredited by the OSV and this will also be used in media. The clubs agree to the production and publication of photo and film material by submitting their entries.

The OSV assumes neither liability nor responsibility for recordings made and published by athletes, spectators and officials.
